District Coordinators & Coach/Manager Roles & Responsibilities

District Roll-Off (MUST BE COMPLETED BY DECEMBER 31st, 2025)

- Set the date for your district roll-off.
- Once confirmed, contact the Executive Director (bowling@sasktel.net) by October 31, 2025
- Each District sets their own cost of the roll-off
- Each District may determine the number of games to be played (minimum 5)
- The roll-off should be conducted as a POA tournament
- Top 5 females and top 5 males will advance to the event
- Work with your District Coordinator to promote the competition widely and encourage maximum athlete participation
- Submit roll-off results to the Executive Director at the Bowling Federation

Participation

• All bowlers are welcome. A C5PBA or YBC card is not required, but it's great if they have one.

Winter Games Fees & Registration

- Saskatchewan Winter Games Council charges a \$150 athlete fee, which covers the walk-out uniform (worn at opening ceremonies), transportation, accommodation and meals
- Athletes will also need to purchase a District tournament shirt to be worn during competition
- Please note that sponsorship logos related to liquor, tobacco, or gaming (including casinos) are not permitted during the Games
- Submit a list of all entrants (names and addresses) to the Provincial Technical Liaison.

Selection Coach / Manager

- Coaches must be the same gender as their team. Select one female and one male.
- Coaches must hold Community Coach Certification with Respect in Sport as of December 31st,
 2025
- Coaches, managers and all volunteers must submit mandatory police check with vulnerable sector to the Executive Director at the Bowling Federation by January 15th, 2026

District Coach / Manager - Roles & Responsibilities

- Act as a liaison with the District Team and team members' parents/guardians
- Liaise with the District Coordinator, Executive Director, and Provincial Technical Liaison
- Organize team practices.
- Submit athlete names and contact information to the Provincial Technical Liaison.
- Notify the Provincial Technical Liaison immediately of any changes to the District Team or athlete roster.
