New Business:

- Provincial Lineage
 - A discussion took place reviewing the Provincial Lineage in 2025-2026 Bowling Season and was decided to keep the Provincial Lineage the same as in 2024-2025 Bowling Season.
- Bowl Sask will be looking for a new suppliers in the upcoming Bowling Season for National Uniforms as the company we purchased from for the 2024-2025 Bowling Season would not communicate with us and the sizing shirts given to us was not true sizing. And Bowlers and/or family members names were not spelled correctly.
- YBC Elimination Tickets will again be circulated out to the centres with YBC programs.
- Jody MacDonald did more inquiring into the Chase the Ace Fundraiser. And Jody will organize this fundraiser this season, starting in September 2025.
- Scholarships
 - Our members discussed requirements for bowlers receiving Scholarships. Scholarships will be required to be redeemed by a certain age limit and can be used towards education and for tools to get education. Also, a contact information page for the winner and Bowl Sask as to when the Scholarship expires.

- What more can we do for 10 Ten Youth and/or Adult bowlers?
 - No Medals for 10 Pin Youth bowlers, but Gift Card Prizes were a hit!
- We encourage all hosting centres to review the event checklist they are hosting before each event. Bowl Sask Executive will be more actively involved at all events awards presentations.
 - All Coaches at YBC events are encouraged to wear same centre bowling shirts as the youth team they are coaching. Or Coaches will be allowed to wear a Master Bowlers Association of Saskatchewan Shirt while coaching at youth bowling events.

- On all Bowl Sask event posters for Youth or Adult events must now include “ Our Event Hosting Centres have limited access for Special Needs and/or Handicap Accessibility”.
- For 5 pin & 10 pin Singles National events, all Coaches names are to be submitted to Bowl Sask Executive for choosing coaches for these events.
- Going forward, Bowl Sask will start keeping track a list of our eligible Coaches within our Province for Youth events.
- Also, following other Canadian provinces in asking each centre to keep all Coaches Criminal Check records in a secure location in their centres.
- Website Honorarium

- YBC Shoot-Out on line Event
 - A Youth bowler that was participating in this event had rolled-off for one week. The bowlers’ scores were submitted incorrectly. An investigation into the incident saw that the issue was corrected and confirmed by Bowl Canada. A letter will be sent to the Youth bowler stating that due to this issue, the bowler will be suspended from the YBC Shoot Out National for a one (1) year period.

Events to Bid to Host: ***Must be present at meeting to bid and your centre must have sent at least one(1) team to that particular Youth Event you wish to bid to Host. The Bowling Calendar for 2025-2026 Bowling Season was discussed and centres bid on events for their centres to host for 5pin & 10pin events.*

***Host centres...Please remember to make sure you have the proper medals for your event(s) you are hosting before the week of your event(s). Again, please review your Events Checklists!*

The Sask Mixed Event date was decided to be November 9, 2025 at Fairhaven Bowl in Saskatoon, Sk. It will be 4 player teams @ \$200/team with 4 games bowled. *Watch for posters! Get ready to share with all your bowlers in your centres!*

Melissa Raschke did the *Third & Final* for Nominations for YBC Chairperson.

Motion: *B. Andersen/J. Raschke M/S* that nominations cease for YBC Chairperson position.

Blaine Boyle and Jody MacDonald were given a few moments to present their reasoning why they let their name stand for the YBC Chairperson position.

The voting members elected Jody MacDonald as the YBC Chairperson for the upcoming 2 year term.

Motion: *J. Raschke/B. Andersen M/S* that the ballots be destroyed. **Carried.**

Jan Cunningham has resigned as Bowl Sask Treasurer as of September 2025. We have Kristy Wainman from Estevan, Sk interested in the Treasurer position.

The Bowl Sask Executive will communicate with Kristy Wainman regarding the Treasurer position in the month of July, 2025.

The Bowling Federation was discussed at great depth of how the Federation assists our organization.

Motion: *B. Boyle/S. Baer M/S* that the Bowl Sask membership authorizes the Bowl Sask Executive to communicate with the Bowling Federation Executive regarding the Executive Director position in the past 2024-2025 Bowling Season. **Carried.**

Next meeting will be the Annual General Meeting on September 21, 2025 in Regina, SK.
